



THE “EASY-CARE” INSTRUCTIONS OF PARCOLYS

The parcolys floor is highly practical and far the easiest to clean of the boarded floor products. Because of its special water-resistant surface and its not absorbant top layer stains never remain. Cleaning As part of the cleaning, your parcolys boarded floor should simply be vacuumed by using the brushes in the head of the vacuum cleaner. Depending on the level of use and the ensuing level of dirt, you should clean your floor with a damp cloth at regular intervals. Due to the structure of the panels it is advised to wipe them longways. Household cleaning fluids that produce a film, such as washing-up liquid and soft soap, should be avoided since they will leave a residue on the surface of the panel. Moreover the use of following cleaners is not allowed as they contain strong acids and/or salts e.g.: decalcifiers on basis of formic acids and aminosulfoacids, water-outletpipecleaners, hydrochloric acid products, baking-oven cleaners... Suitable products which do not produce a film include alcohol or vinegar-based cleaners. Check always floor cleaners that these do not contain any abrasive agents. Stubborn stains With parcolys, spills that could spell disasters on many floors are so easy to clean up - coffee, tea, fizzy drinks, beer, ketchup, soup, sauces, fruit and milk stains can all be removed with lukewarm water, an alcohol or vinegar-based cleaning agent or an absorbent cloth. Paint, ink, lipstick, nail polish and similar products can easily be removed from the boarded floor by applying nail polish remover, petroleum spirit or a special universal stain remover with a cloth. Special precautions: Although these flooring products are exceptionally hard-wearing, we recommend protecting your flooring by: Attaching felt pads to the feet of chair and table legs, furniture and to the bottom of other pieces of furniture. When moving furniture, never drag items across the floor, always lift. For chairs and other pieces of furniture fitted with castors, only use soft castors. Mopping up any spillage immediately. Not polishing and/or applying varnish to the floor. It is not permitted, as this invalidates your warranty. Not using additional sealants or waxes on the boarded floor. It is not permitted, as this invalidates your warranty. Providing the entrance areas with suitable sized doormats and protective rugs against coarse dirt. Avoiding the use of steam cleaners.
